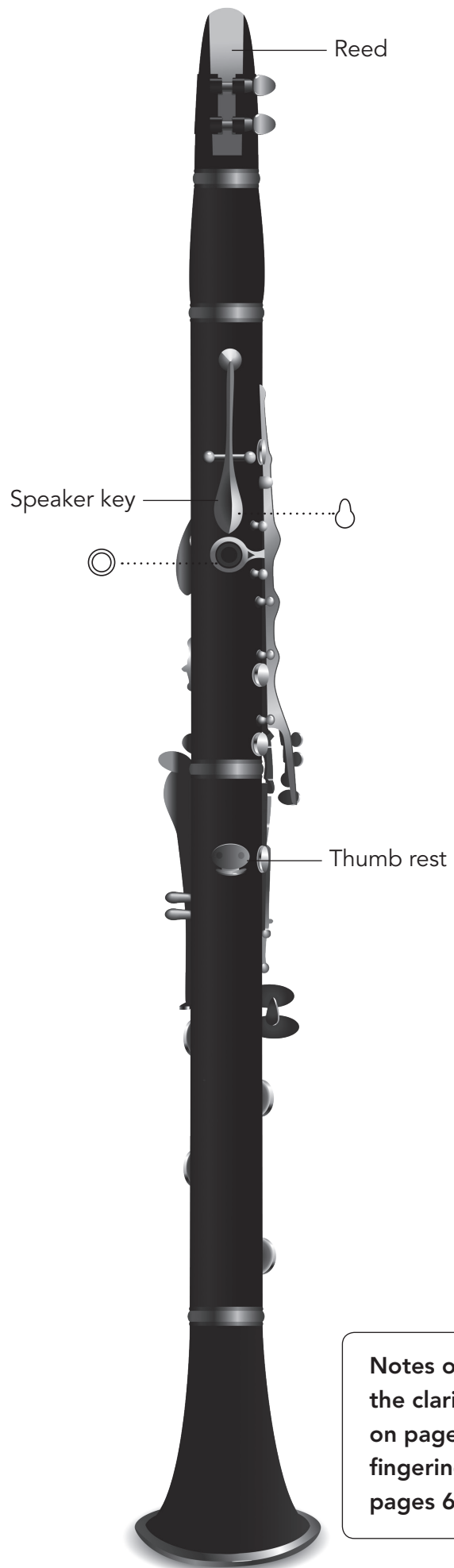
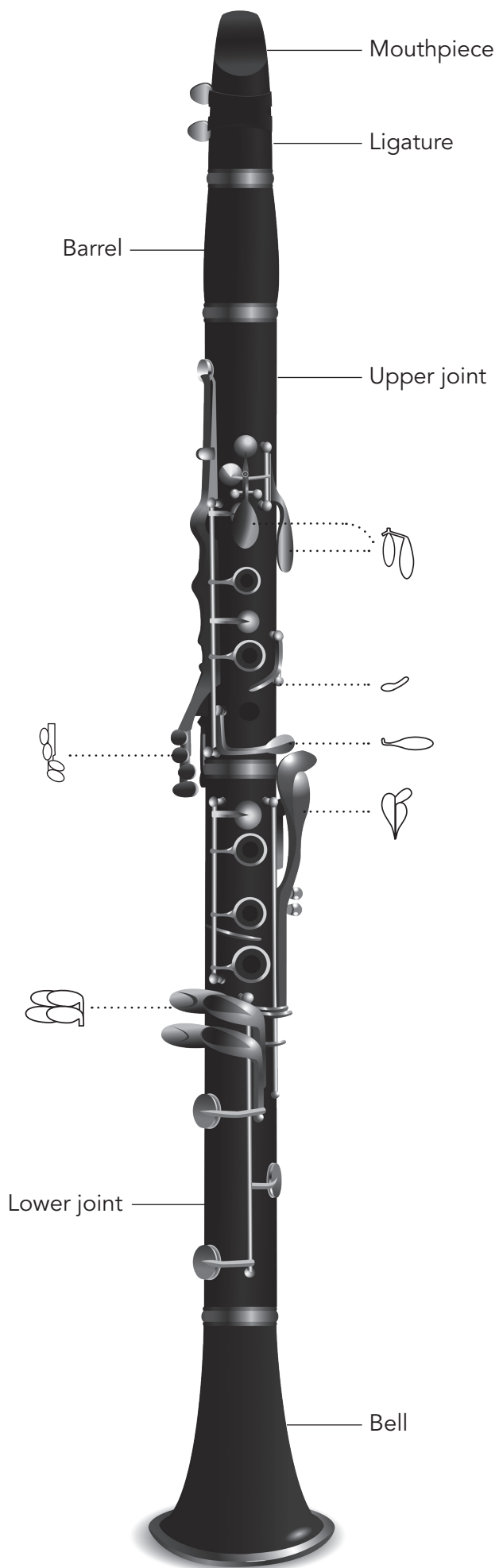



## Activity box



- Clap the following rhythm and write the counting beneath the music:



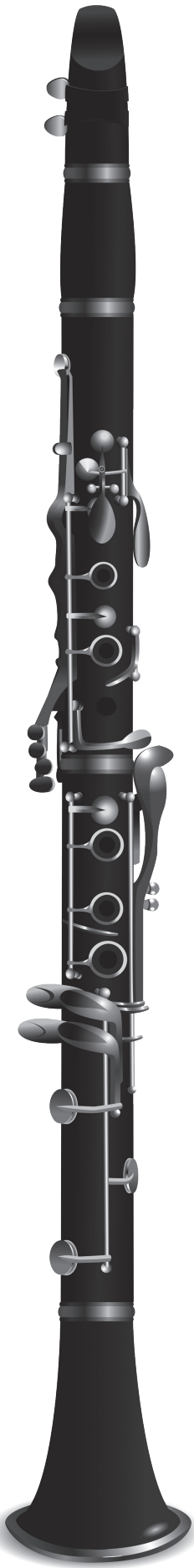
