





The Prologue is performed by 2 S.A.T.B. Choruses. The larger chorus is situated close to the microphones; the smaller chorus is arranged some distance behind to create an echo effect.

n.b. The pitches indicated in the square brackets may be freely selected by the performers and transposed an octave higher or lower, however all pitches indicated must be clearly represented in each section of the Prologue.

Finally overcome, the Searcher falls to the ground.
