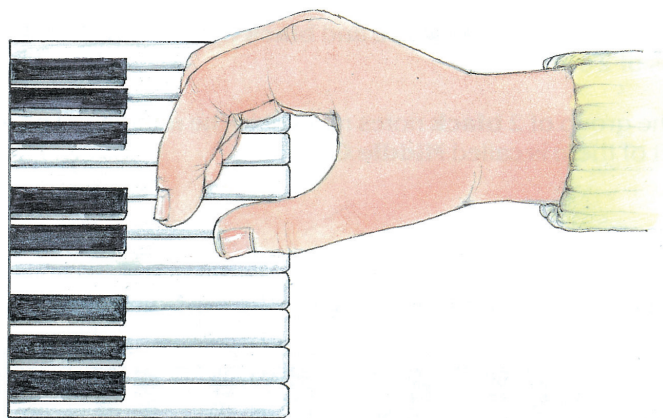
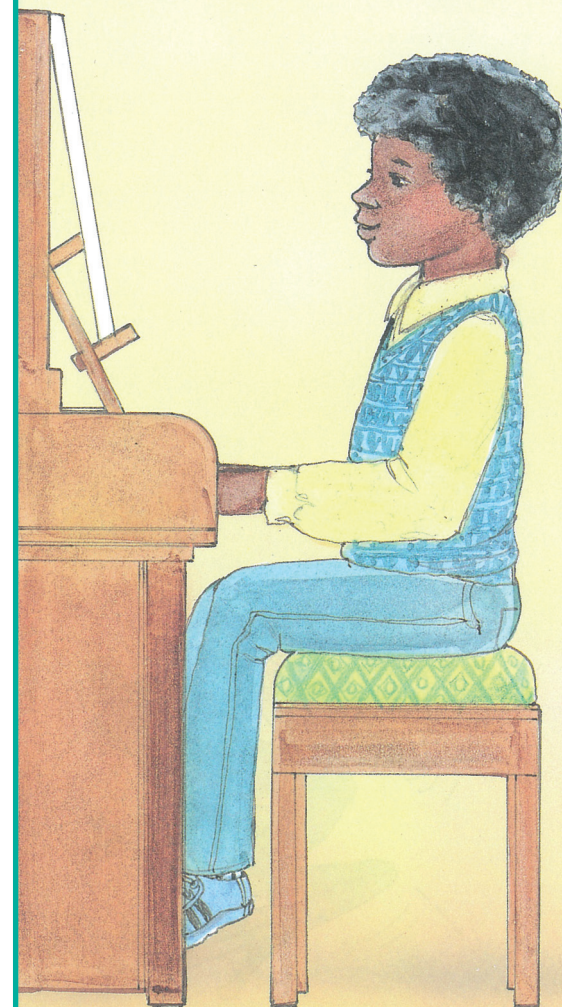


Always
