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Pavillons en l'air was commissioned by the Dartington Summer Arts Foundation for the concert series at the 1991 Dartington International Summer School.
The first performance was given there, in a smaller orchestration, by the Summer School Orchestra conducted by Diego Masson, on 17 August 1991.

The first complete performance of *Diptych* was given by the BBC Symphony Orchestra conducted by Oliver Knussen, in the Barbican Hall, London on 22 April 1995 as part of the BBC's *British Music Now* weekend.

Under its original title (*Dark Night*), *Diptych* was winner of the 1992 Royal Philharmonic Society Prize for Young Composers.
Diptych was also a selected work at the 1996 Paris International Rostrum for Composers.
