ORCHESTRA

flute 1 (doubling alto flute) flute 2 (doubling bass flute) clarinet in Bb or A bassoon

2 horns in F trumpet in Bb

percussion (1 player):

five-octave bass marimba, 2 small metal bars – or anvils (enclumes), bass drum, 3 timpani (large to small), 5 roto-toms (see below)

2 string orchestras (ideally 4.4.3.3.2 players each)

The score is in C Orchestral parts available on hire from the publishers

SEATING ARRANGEMENT

The woodwind and brass players should be positioned in one line along the back of the orchestra. The percussionist should be placed centrally, behind them. String Orchestra I is on the conductor's left. String Orchestra II is on the conductor's right.

ROTO-TOMS

12 pitches are needed as follows:



N.B. These are sounding pitches, <u>never</u> an octave lower or higher.

The part has been arranged for 5 pedal roto-toms, or 5 hand-tuned roto-toms covering:



More drums can be used if available, to reduce the number of retunings. However, there must be at least two which are the smallest available size (less than or equal to 6"/15cm in diameter) in order to obtain the highest pitches which must be played as written (not an octave lower).
