rhythm & beat rehearsal

TECHNICAL TIP: the rhythm fits the words 'Jellyfish lazing around in the sea'.

clap quietly

move hands as if bobbing on waves

wait wait

right left right left

concert piece

TECHNICAL TIP: choose a tempo (speed) which is comfortable for playing pizz. and for swapping between arco and pizz.
CHALLENGE: always listen to the tune as you play the accompaniment.

rhythm & beat rehearsal

tap finger on shoulder of cello

rhythm

CHALLENGE: think up your own ideas for the rhythm or beat to make a 'variation' — a different version.

CHALLENGE: try pizzicato with or without the bow in your hand.

FACT FILE: > accent, a note which stands out.

TECHNICAL TIP: make the note stand out by using extra energy.

tap screw end of bow on stand

wait wait wait wait wait wait wait

stamp on tip toe

one two three four (keep counting and stamping)

FACT FILE: *pp* – *pianissimo*, very quiet; *cresc.* – *crescendo*, get louder bit by bit; *f* – *forte*, loud.
